

<u>Providence Medicare Advantage Plans</u> <u>Monthly Plan Premium for People who get Extra Help from Medicare</u> <u>to Help Pay for their Prescription Drug Costs</u>

If you get extra help from Medicare to help pay for your Medicare prescription drug plan costs, your monthly plan premium will be lower than what it would be if you did not get extra help from Medicare.

If you get extra help, your monthly plan premium will be \$0 for any of the plan(s) below. (This does not include any Medicare Part B premium you may have to pay.)

- Providence Medicare Prime + Rx (HMO)
- Providence Medicare Timber + Rx (HMO)
- Providence Medicare Bridge + Rx (HMO-POS)
- Providence Medicare Cottonwood + Rx (HMO-POS)
- Providence Medicare Pine + Rx (HMO)
- Providence Medicare Sycamore + Rx (HMO)

If you get extra help, your monthly plan premium will be reduced for any of the plan(s) below.

- Providence Medicare Choice + Rx (HMO-POS)
- Providence Medicare Extra + Rx (HMO)

Providence Medicare Advantage Plans' premium includes coverage for both medical services and prescription drug coverage.
