FAQ's	
What is changing?	<ul> <li>American Specialty Health will be delegated for UM, and claims payment for Chiropractic, Acupuncture, alternative care services performed by a Naturopath, and Therapeutic Massage benefits.</li> </ul>
What LOB are impacted and on what dates?	<ul> <li>9/1/25: OR Commercial Large, Small and Individual Groups</li> <li>1/1/26: WA Commercial Large and individual Groups, OR and WA Medicare</li> </ul>
How will medical necessity work?	<ul> <li>Providers must ensure specialty services are medically necessary, with ASH confirming this when their participating providers are used.</li> <li>Providers are responsible for obtaining approval for the member.</li> </ul>
Will there be any disruption for members?	<ul> <li>We don't anticipate any disruption.</li> <li>The ASH network is not changing.</li> <li>Members can continue to go out of network; however, they will be responsible for ensuring their provider obtains the needed authorization.</li> <li>If you are seeing an in-network provider, it's their responsibility to obtain the authorization.</li> </ul>
Will Claims Payment change	<ul> <li>Claims will now be processed and paid by ASH. Providers will receive communication instructing them to send claims to ASH. Claims received at PHP will be forwarded to ASH</li> </ul>
