

Hysterectomy for Benign Conditions

(All Lines of Business Except Medicare)

Effective 2/1/2022

New Policy

- + Medically necessary criteria for hysterectomies for the following benign conditions:
 - Abnormal uterine bleeding
 - Adenomyosis or fibroids
 - Chronic pelvic pain
 - CIN 2, CIN 2/3, CIN 3
 - Endometrial hyperplasia
 - Endometriosis
 - Pelvic inflammatory disease
 - Uterine prolapse
- + Criteria are based on InterQual 2021 criteria.
- + Documentation in the form of medical records, imaging, and chart notes will be required to determine medical necessity of the procedure.
- + See policy for full criteria for each benign condition.
- + **New prior authorization requirement** for hysterectomy specific to the listed benign conditions only will be effective as of 02-01-22
